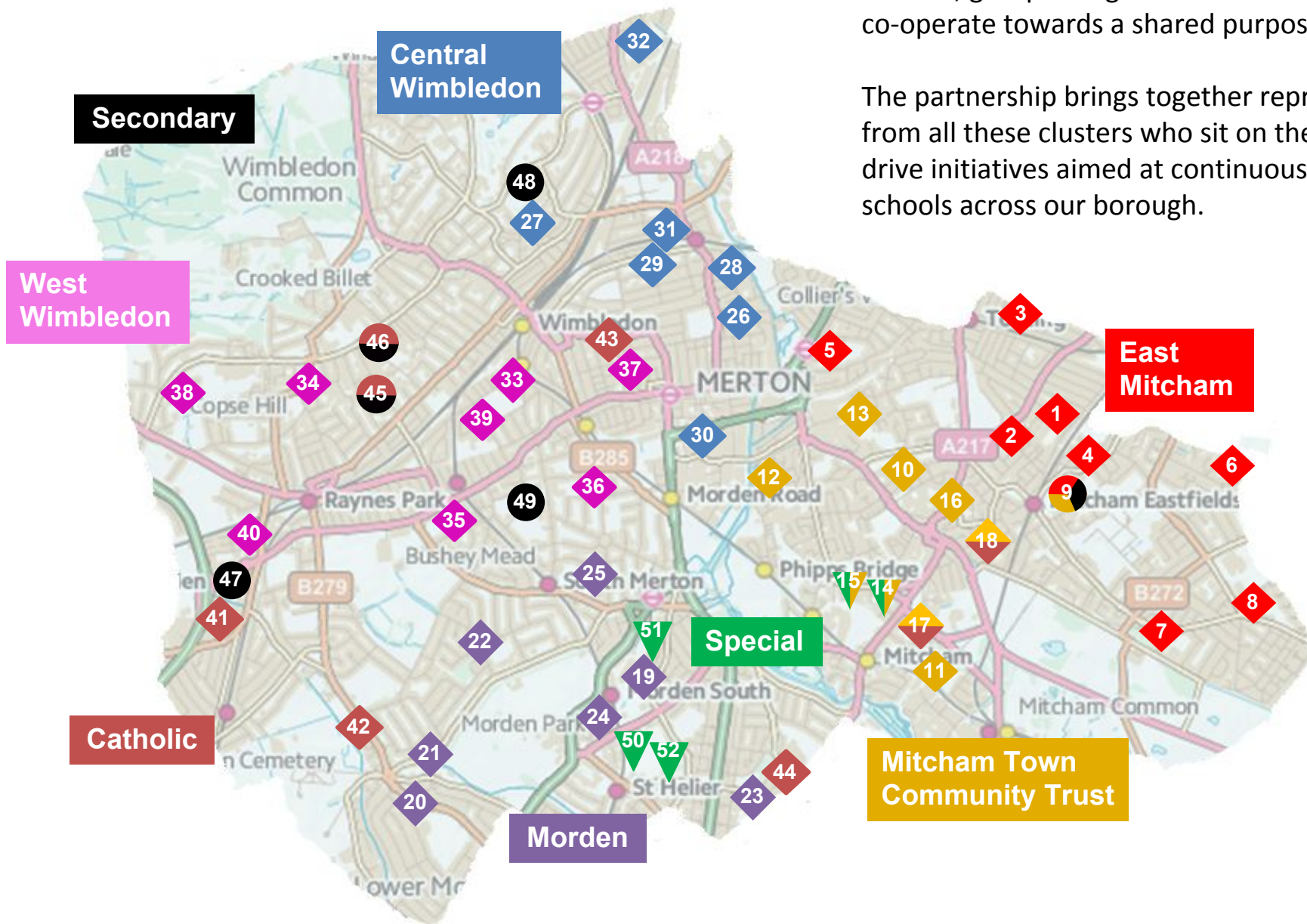


What is ATTAIN?
