## **Request for Funding from MST A to MSSEP**

**July 2018**

**Title of Project:** NPQML

**Context:** MST A entered into a license arrangement with SSAT to provide the NPQML award. The License runs until 31<sup>st</sup> June 2019 and the license holder may run the programme as many times as sees fit within that period, with a maximum of 20 participants. MST A complete its first cohort in September 2018. Update of places to the first cohort was very low and the project is currently running at a loss. Anecdotal information suggests that budget pressures have meant that many schools have been unable to find the necessary funds, to enable their middle leaders to attend, even though there is an identified need.

MST A would like to run a second cohort starting in November 2018.

**Course content:** As prescribed by the DFE. The SSAT materials are very comprehensive.

**Costings and financial request:** A charge of £950 per participant allows MST A to break even having factored in basic costs for those delivering the programme. MST A proposes that a contribution of £500 per participant, up to a maximum of 16 participants, be secured via MSSEP – a potential total of **£8000**.

MST A further proposes that places are allocated on a first come first served basis. Notification would be in the MST A course brochure and individual fliers to Headteachers and officers.
